After the broadcast

English

Keyword drill - ask, help

- Ask the pupils the meaning of the keywords, one at a time.
- Provide help where necessary.
- Ask the pupils to use the key words in sentences.

Story

- Ask the following questions related to the story:
 - What happened to Mimi's book?
It fell in the river
 - Who helped to get Mimi's book from the river?
Jessica the fish
 - Who likes helping Friends?
Jessica the Fish

Game

- Tell the pupils to be in pairs, partner A and partner B.
- Tell partners B to ask for a book from partners A, using the polite word **Please**.
- Tell partners A to respond politely by using **Thank you**.
- Ask partner B to respond with **You are welcome**.
- Teacher, please guide the pupils as they do this.
 - Partner B - Please give me your book.
 - Partner A - Here is the book.
 - Partner B - Thank you.
 - Partner A - You are welcome.

Mathematics

Different big and small numbers.

- Write the following numbers on the board:
999 - 888 - 750 - 699 - 1,240 - 2,579 - 2,311
- Ask the pupils to copy numbers in their books
- Ask the pupils to tell which numbers are bigger and which ones are smaller.
- Go round to help the pupils.
